

GINGERBREAD COTTAGE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB43282 Light Up Cottage

Medium Brush

Large Brush

Writer Bottle

COLORS

CMM 13 - Cinnamon Stick CMM 61 - Chocolate CMM 67 - Snowflake



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start out by painting 3 coats of Chocolate to the roof, the awning above the door, and the base.
- 2. Water down some Snowflake paint with 50% water to 50% paint. Dip your medium brush into the watered down paint and rub your finger over the bristles to spray the paint onto the roof and base to look like snow.
- 3. Paint the remainder of the cottage with 3 coats of Cinnamon Stick.
- 4. Get a writer bottle of Snowflake, it's best if it's only about 1/2 full. Get the bottle working on a paper towel to test it before you go to your piece.
- 5. Lay the cottage down on it's side and working one side at a time put on your lines and flourishes. When one side has lost it's shine, then you can rotate to the next side.
- 6. Once all the sides are done and dry you can put the lines on the roof. We simply did a row of U-shapes across the top and then kept making rows as we went down.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- The harder your squeeze on the bottle the heavier the paint will flow out. Use a steady light pressure for even lines.
- You can squeeze the bottle onto a paper towel at any time to move any air out and prevent sputtering.
