

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use the NCR pattern to trace on the pattern to the center of the plate by pressing firmly with a pen as you trace over the design.
2. Paint the edges of the plate with 3 coats of Storm using a fan brush.
3. While the Storm is still dry, sponge on a light layer of Battleship starting on the edge of the plate and working in ward. If you need help blending the colors, go back with Storm and sponge some of that onto the Battleship.
4. Fill in the sky with 3 coats of Sky Blue.
5. Use a detail brush to fill in the letters with 3 coats of the desired colors. We used Red Head, Grasshopper, Sunny Side Up, and Orange Juice.
6. Fill in the brick boxes and the ground with 3 coats of Red Rocks. We can trace the pattern back onto these since it will get covered when painted.
7. Use a detail brush to paint in the yellow squares working around the question mark to leave them white.
8. Use Kiwi to fill in the bush and the left half of the pipe with 3 coats of paint.
9. Now, use Grasshopper to fill in the hill and the right side of the pipe.
10. Use a marker to draw on the rectangles and circles on the bottom edge. Fill in with Battleship and Licorice using 3 coats of paint.
11. Trace the patterns back onto the ground and the brown blocks.
12. Water Licorice down with 50% water to 50% paint. Create a broken outline around the elements and add the patterns back in on the ground and blocks.
13. Paint 1 generous coat of Licorice around the letters to create the shadow.

TIPS

- When using a liner brush, the harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be.
- 3 coats of paint will give you a solid color.
- The marker will burn off completely in the firing process.

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
